Presidents Report

Your community needs you to be active and participate more now than ever before!

CFU - The JRA fully support the initiative to establish Community Fire Units here in Jerrabomberra. Residents in a few vulnerable locations have already undergone practical and theory training sessions and, so far, three CFU's have been set up in Myrtle Close, Tully Place and the other in Redwood/Wentworth Avenue. Other residents in vulnerable areas are highly encouraged to join the program before the bushfire season. Talk to your neighbours – they might be wondering if you're interested too. Draft LEP Tralee - It's no secret that the JRA support the proposed development of the Jerrabomberra Valley. The Draft Local Environment Plan for South Tralee is back on public exhibition until 2 November. All previous submissions were voided due to a technicality in wording – not a problem with the development itself. To help the Jerrabomberra Valley get the

community facilities we desperately need, put in a submission in support of South Tralee. Every submission will help.

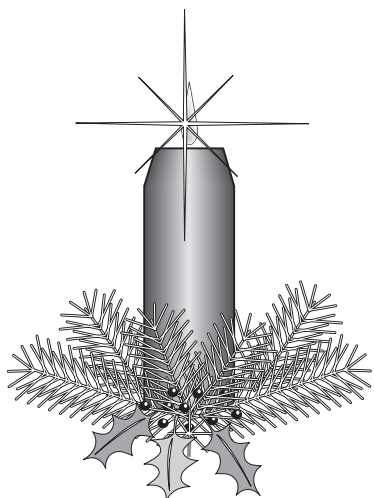
